DAY 1: WELCOME TO WINNIPEG – Guests will arrive into Winnipeg and check into their hotel; Evening meet and greet hosted by Frontiers North Interpretive Guide. (MEALS: NONE)

DAY 2: CHURCHILL ADVENTURE BEGINS – Early morning flight to Churchill; Interpretive transfer; Overnight at Churchill hotel. (MEALS: B, L, D)

DAY 3: TUNDRA BUGGY ADVENTURE – Full-day Tundra Buggy adventure in the Churchill Wildlife Management Area; Overnight at Churchill hotel. (MEALS: B, L, D)



DAY 4: DOG SLEDDING AND ITSANITAQ MUSEUM – Dog sledding and interpretive program; Itsanitaq Museum; Overnight at Churchill hotel (MEALS: B, L, D)

DAY 5: FINAL TUNDRA BUGGY ADVENTURE – Full-day Tundra Buggy adventure in the Churchill Wildlife Management Area; Evening flight to Winnipeg; Guests will check into their Winnipeg hotel. (MEALS: B, L, D)

DAY 6: DEPART WINNIPEG – Guests may depart at their leisure. (MEALS: NONE)

SAMPLE ACTIVITIES

CULTURAL PRESENTATION: An evening presentation from a local resident on the culture, history, wildlife and/or lifestyle of Churchill.

CHURCHILL AND AREA TOUR: A guided bus tour of Churchill's most notable sites, including the Polar Bear Holding Facility and Inukshuk.

DOG SLEDDING: Learn about Métis culture, the history of dog sledding and enjoy an exhilarating dog sled ride.

ITSANITAQ MUSEUM: Tour one of Canada's finest Inuit collections dating from pre- Dorset, Dorset, Thule and modern Inuit times.

PARKS CANADA VISITOR CENTRE: View incredibly detailed wildlife dioramas and fur trade exhibits that represent the history of Churchill.

POLAR BEARS INTERNATIONAL HOUSE: Hear from a Polar Bears International representative and tour the centre to learn about polar bear research and climate change.

TUNDRA BUGGY® ADVENTURE: Search for wild polar bears on a full-day Tundra Buggy adventure in the Churchill Wildlife Management Area.
