DAY 1: WELCOME TO WINNIPEG – Guests will arrive into Winnipeg and check into their hotel at the Winnipeg airport; Evening meet and greet hosted by Frontiers North Interpretive Guide. (MEALS: NONE)

DAY 2: CHURCHILL ADVENTURE BEGINS – Early morning flight to Churchill; Churchill and area tour; Itsanitaq Museum; Parks Canada Visitor Centre; Overnight at Churchill hotel. (MEALS: B, L, D)

DAY 3: DOG SLEDDING AND TUNDRA BUGGY LODGE – Dog sledding and interpretive program; PBI House; Afternoon Tundra Buggy transfer to the Tundra Buggy Lodge; Overnight at Tundra Buggy Lodge. (MEALS: B, L, D)

DAY 4: TUNDRA BUGGY ADVENTURE AND POLAR BEARS INTERNATIONAL SPEAKER – Full-day Tundra Buggy adventure in the Churchill Wildlife Management Area; Presentation from Polar Bears International scientist; Overnight at Tundra Buggy Lodge. (MEALS: B, L, D)

DAY 5: FINAL TUNDRA BUGGY ADVENTURE – Full-day Tundra Buggy adventure in the Churchill Wildlife Management Area; Evening flight to Winnipeg; Guests will check into their Winnipeg hotel. (MEALS: B, L, D)

DAY 6: DEPART WINNIPEG – Guests may depart Winnipeg at their leisure. (MEALS: NONE)

SAMPLE ACTIVITIES

CHURCHILL AND AREA TOUR: A guided bus tour of Churchill's most notable sites, including the Polar Bear Holding Facility and Inukshuk.

DOG SLEDDING: Learn about Métis culture, the history of dog sledding and enjoy an exhilarating dog sled ride.

ITSANITAQ MUSEUM: Tour one of Canada's finest Inuit collections dating from pre- Dorset, Dorset, Thule and modern Inuit times.

POLAR BEARS INTERNATIONAL HOUSE: Hear from a Polar Bear International representative and tour the centre to learn about polar bear research and climate change.

PARKS CANADA VISITOR CENTRE: View incredibly detailed wildlife dioramas and fur trade exhibits that represent the history of Churchill.

TUNDRA BUGGY® ADVENTURE: Search for wild polar bears on a full-day Tundra Buggy adventure in the Churchill Wildlife Management Area.
