DAY 1: WELCOME TO WINNIPEG – Guests will arrive into Winnipeg and make their own way to their hotel; Free time to explore Forks National Historic Site; Evening meet and greet hosted by Frontiers North Interpretive Guide. (MEALS: NONE)

DAY 2: ASSINIBOINE PARK CONSERVANCY – Behind-the-scenes tour of Assiniboine Park Zoo Journey to Churchill exhibit; Free time to explore downtown Winnipeg; Overnight at hotel. (MEALS: B, L)

DAY 3: CHURCHILL ADVENTURE BEGINS – Early morning flight to Churchill; Churchill and area tour; Dog sledding and interpretive program; Pizza dinner and bowling with Junior Rangers; Overnight at Churchill hotel. (MEALS: B, L, D)

DAY 4: TUNDRA BUGGY ADVENTURE – Full-day Tundra Buggy adventure in the Churchill Wildlife Management Area; Overnight at Churchill hotel. (MEALS: B, L, D)



DAY 5: MUSEUMS, FAMILY RECREATION AND YURT EXPERIENCE – Parks Canada Visitor Centre; PBI House; Family recreation activities; Yurt experience; Overnight at Churchill hotel. (MEALS: B, L, D)

DAY 6: FINAL TUNDRA BUGGY ADVENTURE – Full-day Tundra Buggy adventure in the Churchill Wildlife Management Area; Evening flight to Winnipeg; Guests will check into their Winnipeg hotel. (MEALS: B, L, D)

DAY 7: DEPART WINNIPEG – Guests may depart Winnipeg at their leisure. (MEALS: NONE)

SAMPLE ACTIVITIES

ASSINIBOINE PARK CONSERVANCY: Visit Winnipeg's Assiniboine Park Conservancy for an introduction of Churchill's beluga whale population.

CHURCHILL AND AREA TOUR: A guided bus tour of Churchill's most notable sites, including the Polar Bear Holding Facility and Inukshuk.

DOG SLEDDING: Learn about Métis culture, the history of dog sledding and enjoy an exhilarating dog sled ride.

FAMILY RECREATION: Enjoy family play and swim time at the Churchill swimming pool complex.

JUNIOR RANGERS: Share a pizza dinner and a family bowling game hosted by local kids in the community.

PARKS CANADA VISITOR CENTRE: View incredibly detailed wildlife dioramas and fur trade exhibits that represent the history of Churchill.

PBI HOUSE: Hear from a PBI representative and tour the centre to learn about polar bear research and climate change.

TUNDRA BUGGY® ADVENTURE: Search for wild polar bears on a full-day Tundra Buggy adventure in the Churchill Wildlife Management Area.

YURT EXPERIENCE: Travel to a secluded yurt in the boreal forest for dinner and an outdoor family activity.

HUDSON BAY HELICOPTER TOUR: Experience the majesty of Canada's largest ecosystem from approximately 100m (400ft) above the ground.
