The Tundra Buggy Lodge is seasonally positioned at Polar Bear Point in the Churchill Wildlife Management Area, home to the largest concentration of polar bears in the Churchill area. The Lodge offers a unique, immersive experience; at night, when conditions are right, you can view the dance of the northern lights from the rooftop observation deck and wake up to curious polar bears right outside your window in the morning.

Each day, you will be led on a Tundra Buggy excursion directly from your accommodations to explore the Churchill Wildlife Management Area to maximize your polar bear viewing opportunities. Evenings at the Lodge can be just as memorable, with delectable, regionally inspired dishes created by your private Lodge chef and ample time to swap stories with other guests and enjoy regional cuisine. As a guest at the Tundra Buggy Lodge, you are also invited to enjoy exclusive evening presentations hosted by Polar Bears International species experts.

DAY 1: WELCOME TO WINNIPEG – Guests will arrive into Winnipeg and check into their hotel; Evening meet and greet hosted by Frontiers North Interpretive Guide; (MEALS: NONE)

DAY 2: CHURCHILL ADVENTURE BEGINS – Early morning flight to Churchill; Churchill and area tour; Itsanitaq Museum; Overnight at Churchill hotel. (MEALS: B, L, D)

DAY 3: DOG SLEDDING AND TUNDRA BUGGY LODGE – Dog sledding and interpretive program; Parks Canada Visitor Centre; Afternoon Tundra Buggy transfer to the Tundra Buggy Lodge; Overnight at Tundra Buggy Lodge. (MEALS: B, L, D)

DAY 4: TUNDRA BUGGY ADVENTURE – Full-day Tundra Buggy adventure in the Churchill Wildlife Management Area; Overnight at Tundra Buggy Lodge. (MEALS: B, L, D)



DAY 5: TUNDRA BUGGY ADVENTURE – Full-day Tundra Buggy adventure in the Churchill Wildlife Management Area; Overnight at Tundra Buggy Lodge. (MEALS: B, L, D)

DAY 6: FINAL TUNDRA BUGGY ADVENTURE – Full-day Tundra Buggy adventure in the Churchill Wildlife Management Area; Evening flight to Winnipeg; Guests will check into their Winnipeg hotel. (MEALS: B, L, D)

DAY 7: DEPART WINNIPEG – Guests may depart Winnipeg at their leisure. (MEALS: NONE)

SAMPLE ACTIVITIES

CULTURAL PRESENTATION: An evening presentation from a local resident on the culture, history, wildlife and/or lifestyle of Churchill.

CHURCHILL AND AREA TOUR: A guided bus tour of Churchill's most notable sites, including the Polar Bear Holding Facility and Inukshuk.

DOG SLEDDING: Learn about Métis culture, the history of dog sledding and enjoy an exhilarating dog sled ride.

ITSANITAQ MUSEUM: Tour one of Canada's finest Inuit collections dating from pre- Dorset, Dorset, Thule and modern Inuit times.

PARKS CANADA: View incredibly detailed wildlife dioramas and fur trade exhibits that represent the history of Churchill.

TUNDRA BUGGY® ADVENTURE: Search for wild polar bears on a full-day Tundra Buggy adventure in the Churchill Wildlife Management Area.

HUDSON BAY HELICOPTER TOUR: Experience the majesty of Canada's largest ecosystem from approximately 100m (400ft) above the ground.
