



Experience the spectacular wildlife of Manitoba with an adventure from the expansive forests and grasslands of Riding Mountain National Park, to the colourful tundra of Churchill. Our one-of-a-kind Big Five Safari is a salute to the incredible array of megafauna that populate the forests, prairies, tundra and waters of this beautiful province.

Your journey begins in Winnipeg, the geographic centre of North America. Travel overland to Riding Mountain National Park where the boreal forest, meadows and lakes, lofty heights and deep gorges of the Manitoba Escarpment are home to moose, black bears, a captive bison herd and more. Enjoy daily wildlife drives to photograph the amazing wildlife and landscapes of the area.

Next, fly north to Churchill, where the boreal forest gives way to the rugged tundra and northern waterways. Set out by boat and Zodiac amongst inquisitive beluga whales and explore the Churchill Wildlife Management Area in search of the majestic polar bear.

DAY 1: WELCOME TO WINNIPEG - Guests will arrive into Winnipeg and check into their hotel at the Winnipeg airport; Evening welcome dinner hosted by Frontiers North Interpretive Guide. (MEALS: D)

**DAY 2: WILDLIFE SAFARI IN RIDING MOUNTAIN NATIONAL PARK** – Morning bus transfer to RMNP; Stop at Farmery Estate Brewery; Evening wildlife drive; Overnight at Lakehouse hotel. (MEALS: B, L, D)

DAY 3: LAKE AUDY BISON ENCLOSURE - Morning wildlife drive; Interpretive walking tour of Wasagaming; Interpretive cruise on Clear Lake aboard The Martese; Evening wildlife drive to Lake Audy Bison Enclosure; Overnight at Lakehouse hotel. (MEALS: B, L, D)

DAY 4: FINAL WILDLIFE SAFARI IN RMNP - Morning wildlife drive; Ominik Marsh interpretive hike; Return by bus to Winnipeg; Check in for the evening at Winnipeg hotel. (MEALS: B, L, D)



DAY 5: CHURCHILL ADVENTURE BEGINS - Flight to Churchill; Tundra Buggy adventure in the Churchill Wildlife Management Area; Free time to explore Churchill; Overnight at Churchill hotel. (MEALS: B, L, D)

### **DAY 6: BELUGA WHALES AND PRINCE OF WALES FORT**

**TOUR** – Churchill and area tour; Polar Bears International House; Boat tour of the Churchill River; Interpretive walking tour of Prince of Wales Fort; Dog carting and interpretive program; Overnight at Churchill hotel. (MEALS: B, L, D)

DAY 7: LAST DAY IN CHURCHILL - Zodiac boat ride on the Churchill River; Parks Canada Visitor Centre; Itsanitaq Museum; Evening flight to Winnipeg; Guests will check into their Winnipeg hotel. (MEALS: B, L, D)

# SAMPLE ACTIVITIES

BISON ENCLOSURE: Visit Lake Audy's bison enclosure and learn about the history and importance of the bison in North America.

BELUGA AND FORT TOUR: Discover hundreds of beluga whales by boat and enjoy a guided tour of Prince of Wales Fort National Historic Site.

BELUGA BOAT TOUR: Get a behindthe-scenes tour of the Beluga Boat, a vessel documenting the belugas in the Churchill River.

BELUGA ZODIAC: A guided excursion into the Churchill River beluga whale estuary in an inflatable Zodiac boat.

Churchill's most notable sites, including the Polar Bear Holding Facility and Inukshuk.

DOG CARTING: Learn about Métis culture, the history of dog sledding and enjoy an exhilarating dog cart ride.

ITSANITAQ MUSEUM: Tour one of Canada's finest Inuit collections dating from pre- Dorset, Dorset, Thule and modern Inuit times.

INTERPRETIVE CRUISE: Enjoy an afternoon cruise of Clear Lake aboard The Martese.

INTERPRETIVE HIKE: Hike through the scenic wetlands of RMNP's Ominik Marsh.

INTERPRETIVE WALKING TOUR: Take in the historic townsite of Wasagaming, located in the heart of RMNP, on an interpretive walking tour.
