DAY 1: WELCOME TO WINNIPEG – Guests will arrive into Winnipeg and make their own way to Inn at the Forks hotel; Evening welcome dinner hosted by Frontiers North Photo Specialist. (MEALS: D)

DAY 2: THE MANITOBA MUSEUM – Manitoba Planetarium presentation; Interactive “Inuit: People of the North” program; Overnight at Inn at the Forks hotel. (MEALS: B, L, D)

DAY 3: CHURCHILL ADVENTURE BEGINS – Early morning flight to Churchill; Introductory northern lights photography workshop; Evening forest excursion; Overnight at Churchill hotel. (MEALS: B, L, D)

DAY 4: EXPLORE CHURCHILL AND THE NORTHERN LIGHTS – Churchill and area tour; Parks Canada Visitor Centre; Dan’s Diner culinary experience; Overnight at Churchill hotel. (MEALS: B, L, D)



DAY 5: DOG SLEDDING AND THANADELTHUR LOUNGE – Dog sledding and interpretive program; Evening visit to Thanadelthur Lounge; Overnight at Churchill hotel. (MEALS: B, L, D)

DAY 6: SNOWSHOE TREK AND WAPUSK ADVENTURES – Interpretive snowshoe trek; Evening visit to Wapusk Adventures; Overnight at Churchill hotel. (MEALS: B, L, D)

DAY 7: LAST DAY IN CHURCHILL – Itsanitaq Museum; Polar Bears International House; Evening flight to Winnipeg; Guests will check into their hotel at the Winnipeg airport. (MEALS: B, L, D)

DAY 8: DEPART WINNIPEG – Guests may depart Winnipeg at their leisure. (MEALS: NONE)

SAMPLE ACTIVITIES

ASSINIBOINE PARK

CONSERVANCY: Visit Winnipeg’s Assiniboine Park Conservancy for an introduction of Churchill’s beluga whale population.

ARTIST WORKSHOP: Meet a local Churchill artist for an art workshop with the whole family.

BELUGA BOAT TOUR: Get a behind-the-scenes tour of the Beluga Boat, a vessel documenting the belugas in the Churchill River.

BELUGA AND FORT TOUR: Discover hundreds of beluga whales by boat and enjoy a guided tour of Prince of Wales Fort National Historic Site. Sample Activities.

BELUGA KAYAK†: Get closer to the beluga whales on a kayaking excursion in the Churchill River.

DOG CARTING: Learn about Métis culture, the history of dog sledding and enjoy an exhilarating dog cart ride.

FAMILY RECREATION: Enjoy family play and swim time at the Churchill swimming pool complex.

INTERPRETIVE TRANSFER: During transfer to your accommodations, receive guided interpretation of Churchill’s points of interest.

JUNIOR RANGERS: Share a pizza dinner and a family bowling game hosted by local kids in the community.

NATURE WALK: Experience a guided hike through the unique summer landscape of Churchill.

PARKS CANADA VISITOR CENTRE: Hear from a Polar Bears International representative and tour the centre to learn about polar bear research and climate change.

POLAR BEARS INTERNATIONAL HOUSE: Hear from a Polar Bears Interpretive representative and tour the centre to learn about polar bear research and climate change.

TUNDRA BUGGY® ADVENTURE: Search for summer wildlife on a Tundra Buggy adventure in the Churchill Wildlife Management Area.

HUDSON BAY HELICOPTER TOUR: Experience the majesty of Canada’s largest ecosystem from approximately 100m (400ft) above the ground.
