DAY 4: DAN’S DINER CULINARY EXPERIENCE – Churchill and area tour; Parks Canada Visitor Centre; Dan’s Diner culinary experience; Overnight at Churchill hotel. (MEALS: B, L, D)

DAY 5: DOG SLEDDING AND THANADELTHUR LOUNGE – Dog sledding and interpretive program; Evening visit to Thanadelthur Lounge; Overnight at Churchill hotel. (MEALS: B, L, D)

DAY 6: SNOWSHOE TREK AND WAPUSK ADVENTURES – Interpretive snowshoe trek; Evening visit to Wapusk Adventures; Overnight at Churchill hotel. (MEALS: B, L, D)

DAY 7: LAST DAY IN CHURCHILL – Itsanitaq Museum; Polar Bears International House; Evening flight to Winnipeg; Guests will check into their hotel at the Winnipeg airport. (MEALS: B, L, D)

DAY 8: DEPART WINNIPEG – Guests may depart Winnipeg at their leisure. (MEALS: NONE)

SAMPLE ACTIVITIES

CULINARY EXPERIENCE: Travel by Tundra Buggy across the frozen river to Dan’s Diner, an exclusive pop-up restaurant in the wilderness.

CHURCHILL AND AREA TOUR: A guided bus tour of Churchill’s most notable sites, including the Polar Bear Holding Facility and Inukshuk.

DOG SLEDDING: Learn about Métis culture, the history of dog sledding and enjoy an exhilarating dog sled ride.

FOREST EXCURSION: Escape the lights of town for aurora borealis-viewing opportunities from an extraordinary locale in the boreal forest.

ITSANITAQ MUSEUM: Tour one of Canada’s finest Inuit collections dating from pre- Dorset, Dorset, Thule and modern Inuit times.

MANITOBA MUSEUM PROGRAM: Explore renowned exhibitions focussed on human and natural heritage themes that tell the story of Manitoba.

PARKS CANADA VISITOR CENTRE: View incredibly detailed wildlife dioramas and fur trade exhibits that represent the history of Churchill.

PBI HOUSE: Hear from a PBI representative and tour the centre to learn about polar bear research and climate change.

PHOTO WORKSHOP: Partake in an introductory photo workshop led by one of our Photo Specialist guides.

SNOWSHOE TREK: Enjoy the solace of an interpretive snowshoeing adventure through the boreal forest.

THANADELTHUR LOUNGE: Travel by Tundra Buggy across the river to our warm and secluded lounge for peak aurora-viewing opportunities.

TUNDRA BUGGY® ADVENTURE: Take a ride on an official Tundra Buggy to Churchill’s remote locales for aurora borealis-viewing opportunities.

WINNIPEG PLANETARIUM: Enjoy a guided tour of Winnipeg’s night sky, highlighting current constellations, planets and northern lights.
