DAY 1: WELCOME TO WINNIPEG – Guests will check into their departure city hotel; Evening meet and greet hosted by Frontiers North Interpretive Guide; Overnight at departure city hotel. (MEALS: NONE)

DAY 2: CHURCHILL ADVENTURE BEGINS – Early morning flight to Churchill; Churchill and area tour; Parks Canada Visitor Centre; Dan's Diner culinary experience; Evening visit to Thanadelthur Lounge; Overnight at Churchill hotel. (MEALS: B, L, D)

DAY 3: DOG SLEDDING, SNOWSHOES AND NORTHERN LIGHTS – Dog sledding and interpretive program; Interpretive snowshoe trek; Evening forest excursion; Overnight at Churchill hotel. (MEALS: B, L, D)

DAY 4: LAST DAY IN CHURCHILL – Free time to explore the town of Churchill; Itsanitaq Museum; Evening flight to departure city; Guests check back into their hotel. (MEALS: B, L, D)

DAY 5: DEPART WINNIPEG – Guests may depart at their leisure. (MEALS: NONE)

SAMPLE ACTIVITIES

CULINARY EXPERIENCE: Travel by Tundra Buggy across the frozen river to Dan's Diner, an exclusive pop-up restaurant in the wilderness.

CHURCHILL AND AREA TOUR: A guided bus tour of Churchill's most notable sites, including the Polar Bear Holding Facility and Inukshuk.

DOG SLEDDING: Learn about Métis culture, the history of dog sledding and enjoy an exhilarating dog sled ride.

FOREST EXCURSION: Escape the lights of town for aurora borealis-viewing opportunities from an extraordinary locale in the boreal forest.

ITSANITAQ MUSEUM: Tour one of Canada's finest Inuit collections dating from pre- Dorset, Dorset, Thule and modern Inuit times.

PARKS CANADA VISITOR CENTRE: View incredibly detailed wildlife dioramas and fur trade exhibits that represent the history of Churchill.

SNOWSHOE TREK: Enjoy the solace of an interpretive snowshoeing adventure through the boreal forest.

THANADELTHUR LOUNGE: Travel by Tundra Buggy across the river to our warm and secluded lounge for peak aurora-viewing opportunities.

TUNDRA BUGGY® ADVENTURE: Take a ride on an official Tundra Buggy to Churchill's remote locales for aurora borealis-viewing opportunities.
